
#### Memorial Day Run!

#### Maintenance Tips

- 1. Prepare your grill for the outdoor cooking season to begin. You can find several easy methods on the internet, but good old fashion elbow grease and a mild detergent is still the preferred method.
- 2. Now is a good time to inspect all your screens. To wash your screens, lay them on a picnic table or saw horses and scrub with a soft brush and mild detergent. Make sure they dry completely before replacing.
- 3. Check caulk and weather stripping around windows and doors for damage and wear
- ${\it 4. Check all Fire Extinguishers to make sure they are not outdated or damaged.}\\$
- 5. Never clean your windows in direct sunlight, they will dry too quickly and cause streaks. Wait until an overcast day or later in the afternoon to wash the inside and outside of your windows.
- 6. Clean and inspect your gutters. Use a garden hose to flush your gutter out and make sure that your downspouts are directing water at least three feet away from your foundation.
- 7. While unpacking your metal patio furniture for the season, coat them in auto polish before setting them out to protect them.
- 8. As part of your Spring cleaning, make sure to check the contents of your medicine cabinet and remove all outdated prescriptions and over the counter medicines.
- 9. Clean the refrigerator, inside and out, with mild detergent. Remove all trays and shelves. Make sure to allow everything to dry thoroughly before replacing them.
- 10. Inspect furniture, cabinets and vanities for loose knobs, pulls and hinges. Lubricate squeaky door hinges with lightweight machine oil
