August Maintenance Tips:

Stretch out these last days of summer by squeezing in a few more home projects, savoring simple pleasures and, when the time comes, cleaning up the beach toys and preparing the house for a busy fall. - •Backyard Bugs...ew! Wasp activity peaks in late summer; these insects become more aggressive and likely to sting in, you guessed it, August.
