Our President's Message



I am pleased to announce that for the third year, Hunt Heroes Foundation, the non-profit organization founded by Hunt Military Communities, will be awarding scholarships to help enable the ongoing education of military members and their families.

Last year we were able to help nine worthy students and awarded \$30,000. Because of the generous donations we received over the past year, we are able to increase scholarship awards and recognize 15 recipients and award \$40,000 in scholarship grants in 2021. I encourage you to apply if you or a loved one meet any of the following criteria: A high school senior or high school graduate or a current postsecondary undergraduate at an accredited two or four-year college, university or vocational school or a trade school student; or Planning to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year.

Winter Weather Reminders

- **Disconnect Garden Hoses** during the winter season to help prevent pipes from freezing and bursting.
- **NEVER Turn Your Heat Off** and keep your thermostat at 65 degrees or higher. Inform your RSS if you are planning to leave town for more than 7 days.
- **Let Your Faucets Drip** in the kitchen and bathrooms, this allows the water to have a constant flow and assists with preventing pipes from freezing.
- **Open Cabinets** during below freezing temperatures in the kitchen and bathroom to allow warm air to reach the pipes.

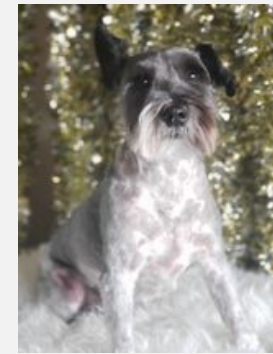
