Winter HVAC Tips

Filter Changes should occur at a minimum of every 3 months. Replacements are provided upon request.

Do NOT Block Air Vents.

Do NOT Block Large Return Air Grille.

Keep Your Thermostat Set at a Comfortable Temperature. A higher thermostat temperature will not heat your home faster.

Check Carbon Monoxide Detectors. which are usually located near the HVAC/Water Heater closet. If you believe your detector is not functional, call in a work order immediately.

Do NOT Attempt to Repair the HVAC unit. Place a work order. **Thermostats Should be set to a Minimum of 65 Degrees. For Patriots Landing Homes** (excluding Knox and Geo Wash) keep the front coat closet door cracked during freezing temperatures. The water supply comes into the home through this closet and keeping the door cracked could prevent frozen pipes.

DID YOU KNOW?

Heat Rises and will likely cause the upstairs to be warmer than downstairs.

Your Outdoor Unit does not heat your home.

Keeping Doors and Windows Closed will help maintain your desired temperature
