Scott Family Housing, the Military Housing Office and Scott's Fire Emergency Services have partnered to offer residents the opportunity to have their fire extinguishers inspected by bringing them to a drive-by quality check! We encourage residents to review the provided Fire Extinguisher Inspection Tips. If any of these tips are applicable or you're unsure if your extinguisher is operable, we recommend participating in the quality check. A member of Fire Emergency Services will inspect the extinguisher further.

#### FIRE EXTINGUISHER INSPECTION TIPS

- **Inspect External Condition** No apparent damage; Easy to
- **Hose** Check to see if it is in place and not broken
- **Nozzle** Nothing stuffed inside the discharge
- Weight Should feel as though it contains agent
- **Pressure Gauge** Within operable range (in the green)

\*Please be aware that these tips DO NOT certify that the extinguisher is serviceable as determined by NFPA 10. Fire extinguishers still have to be certified by the proper authority having jurisdiction.\*
