What's The Purpose?

Appointed Resident Reps represent military members and their families residing in Privatized Housing to discuss health and safety concerns, identify areas of improvement, present solutions for problems, and maximize feedback and communications with Wing Leadership, the Military Housing Office (MHO), and Hunt Military Communities.

Resident Reps Help:

- Identify trends/processes (positive or negative) that impact the resident's living experiences
- Advocate for improvements or amenities that elevate quality of life for residents
- Provide suggestions for activities and events for residents and facilitate planning/execution
- Meet with Installation Commander to provide feedback/concerns from the residents
