COMMUNITY REMINDERS

TIPS: KEEPING THE NEIGHBORHOOD BEAUTIFUL

- Front Flower Beds & Backyards Residents are responsible for ensuring flower beds are well kept, along with any tree rings and fence lines. Mowing and trimming the backyard is also the resident's responsibility. A good rule of thumb: your lawn should not be taller than the grass outside of your fenced-in yard.
- Trash/Recycling/Yard Waste Cans containers may be set out for pick-up no earlier than 1800 on the evening prior to the scheduled pick-up day and must be removed from the curb and returned to the storage area after pick-up, no later than 1800 the next day.
- **Pet Responsibilities** Please keep our grounds clean and sanitary. Pets must always be on a leash when outside fenced yards and should never be left unattended or outside for extended periods.
- **Toys and Outdoor Items** Bikes, toys, lawn equipment, pools, fire pits, and similar items should be stored in the backyard or garage when not in use. Pools must be emptied after each use.
- Trash and Debris should always be disposed of in the appropriate receptacle.
- **Recreational Vehicles** trailers, boats, campers, and similar vehicles are allowed on the property 24 hours before and after use.
- **Flags & Signage** Residents are permitted to fly a United States flag. Any other flags or signs must follow the DoD's Flag guidance. Residents desiring to fly any other flag must obtain approval from housing.

COMMUNITY REMINDERS

UNDERSTANDING THE NOTICE TO VACATE PROCESS

Anticipating an upcoming PCS or looking to purchase a new home off base? Not sure how the moveout process works? We understand that your chapter with us will eventually end, and it will come time for you to move on to your next adventure. When that time comes, we want you to be informed, prepared and confident in what to expect when initiating the move out process.

- All notices must be submitted in writing. Verbal notices are not accepted.
- If you're active duty and anticipate orders, please know that orders are NOT required to submit **notice**, but will be required no later than your final inspection appointment.
- Scott Family Housing requires a **minimum of 30-days'** notice from residents prior to vacating. Notices can be accepted up to 90 days in advance.
- By fulfilling your required 30-days' notice you avoid paying rent for days that you're not actually residing in the home.
- When picking a move-out date, you should choose the latest possible date you could be in the home. Your final inspection may be moved to an earlier date if needed, but because we pre-lease your home once you submit notice, it may not be possible for you to retain the home past your initial vacating date.
- Appointments are scheduled on a first come first serve basis, with end of month appointments usually being the first to fill up.
