Join the Community Advisory Board

The Community Advisor Board (CAB) consists of residents from each neighborhood, the Military Housing Office, and the Scott Family Housing team. CAB meets monthly to address various topics and serves as a liaison between residents and Scott Family Housing. Quarterly, CAB meets with the Wing Commander to discuss resident issues. Preparing for a PCS or planning to buy a home off base? Here's what you need to know about the move-out process at Scott Family Housing:

- Written Notice Required: Verbal notices are not accepted.
- Orders Not Required to Submit Notice: Active-duty members can submit notice without orders, but must provide them by the final inspection.
- **30-Day Minimum Notice:** Submit your notice at least 30 days before vacating (up to 90 days in advance is allowed).
- **Avoid Extra Rent:** Meeting the 30-day notice ensures you don't pay rent for days you're not living in the home.
- Choose Your Move-Out Date Wisely: Select the latest possible date you might need the home. Final inspections can be moved earlier if needed, but extending your stay may not be possible.
- Schedule Early: End-of-month appointments fill up quickly, so book as soon as possible.
