Scott Family Housing proudly manages 1,595 homes across six neighborhoods, with 1,522 homes occupied as of August 31st. That's a vibrant community of families, including Active Service Members, Military Retirees, Reservists, and Government Employees, who call Scott Family Housing "home."

Tips for Keeping the Neighborhood Beautiful

- Front Flower Beds & Backyards: Residents are responsible for ensuring the flower beds are well kept, along with any tree rings and fence lines. They are also responsible for mowing and trimming the backyard. The lawn should not be taller than the grass outside the fence.
- Pet Responsibilities: Residents must keep the grounds clean. Pets should never be left unattended or outside for long periods and must be leashed when not in a fenced yard.
- Bikes, Toys, Lawn Care Equipment, Pools, Fire Pits: When not in use, these items should be moved to the backyard or garage. Pools MUST be emptied after use.
- Recreational Vehicles: Trailers, boats, and campers are authorized 24 hours before and after use.
- Flags and Signage: Residents may display the United States flag. Any other flags or signs must adhere to DoD's Flag Guidance and require housing approval.
