COMMUNITY UPDATES

Winter Weather Tips – use these tips when temperatures drop below 32 degrees:

- **Disconnect Garden Hoses:** All hoses should be disconnected from the outside spigots until spring. Connected hoses during freezing temperatures could result in busted pipes and resident expenses. Exterior faucets should NOT be dripping. If a leak is discovered, call housing immediately.
- Never Turn Your Heat Off: Keep the heat on at 65°F or higher, especially if you'll be away for more than 24 hours.
- Submit a Notice of Absence: Reach out to your neighborhood RSS if you will be away from home for several days.
- Let Your Faucets Drip: Turn on a slow drip in the kitchen and bathrooms to prevent frozen pipes.
- **Leave Cabinets Open:** Opening the cabinets in the kitchen and bathrooms allow warm air to reach the pipes along the exterior walls.
- Open Front Coat Closet (Patriot's Landing only): Patriot's Landing residents should open their front coat closet to allow heat to reach the main water line.

Did you know that Scott Family Housing manages a total of 1,595 homes spread throughout 6 neighborhoods? MAINTENANCE TIPS

Keeping the Neighborhood Beautiful

- Flower Beds & Yards: Residents must maintain flower beds, tree rings, fence lines, and mow/trim backyards. Grass should not be taller than outside the fence.
- Trash/Recycling: Set out your containers after 6:00 PM the night before pickup and return them by 6:00 PM the next day.
- Pets: Keep grounds clean; pets must be leashed outside fenced yards and never left unattended.
- Outdoor Items: Store bikes, toys, equipment, pools, and fire pits in the backyard or garage when not in use. Pools must be emptied after use.
- Trash & Debris: Dispose of all waste in proper receptacles.
- Recreational Vehicles: Trailers, boats, campers allowed 24 hours before and after use.
- Flags & Signs: U.S. flags permitted; all others require housing approval per DoD quidelines.
