March Maintenance Tips:

-Repleace your air filter. While your filter should ideally be changed every 3 months, the beginning of warmer temperatures prompts us to think about changing again. Warmer weather and a clean filter will go a long way in helping keep your air fresh and your family healthy!

-Clean your dryer vent. Not all line is caught in the trap; some of those "fuzz-bunnies" make their way into the dryer vent. A clear vent will save you money by reducing the time your dryer has to run. A clogged vent not only wastes more money, but can also cause house fires.

-Vacuum your refrigerator coils. The coils that you'll find on the bottom or back of your unit conduct the hot air from inside the refrigerator. If they're coated with dust, they do the job less effectively and cause your fridge to work harder and use more energy resulting in a higher electric bill.

-Replace the batteries in your smoke detectors. You never know when you'll need them! Soemtimes, it's a matter of life or death, so take the time to change the batteries now.

-Prepare your lawn mower for Summer, Change the engine oil and sharpen the cutting blade. In doing this, you will lengthen the life of the mower and improve the look of your alwan.
