### **April Maintenance Tips: Spring Cleaning**

**Patio Furniture** - Use an all purpose cleaner on your patio furniture to get rid of any caked on dirt! Start by using mild soap and water on cushions that need spot touch ups.

**Trashcans** - Keep your trashcans nice and fresh by periodically rinsing them with 1/2 cup of bleach, a few drops of dish-washing liquid and 1 gallon of water.

**Shed** - Feel a little more organized by decluttering your shed! Make three different piles for things to "keep, toss or donate". Don't forget to utilize Facebook Market Place!

**Windows** - Let the sun shine in by cleaning the grime off of the outside windows too! Carefully remove screens and gently rinse window with a hose. For tough spots, use soapy water. Remember to be courteous to your neighbors while letting in the fresh air!

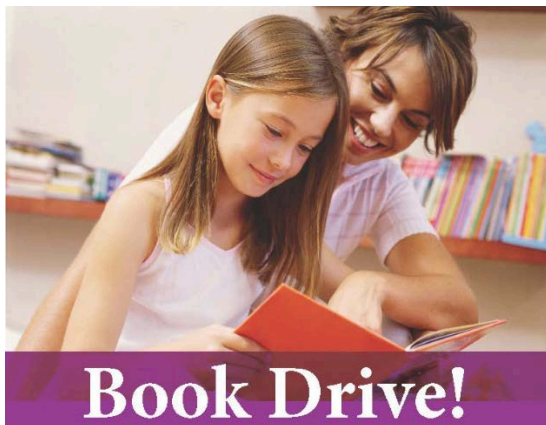
